POLICY FOR MAKE-UP EXAMS

All unexcused absences during exams MUST BE verified with notes from BOTH DOCTOR AND PARENT upon the student's return to school. A DOCTOR'S NOTE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER THREE SCHOOL DAYS. If a student is granted an excused absence on a scheduled exam day, make-up exam will be scheduled during the Make-up/Conflict periods. If an absence is determined to be unexcused, the student will not be permitted to make-up the exam and the grade(s) will be calculated as an "F" (= 0).

FAMILY VACATIONS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID REASON TO BE ABSENT FROM EXAMS AS SCHEDULED ON THE SCHOOL CALENDAR.

All exams must be taken by Friday, June 22. If a student does not take all exams by Friday, June 22, and he or she does not have a doctor's excuse, the student will receive a grade of "zero = 0" for any missed exams.

STUDENTS WHO MISS EXAMS BECAUSE OF OUTSTANDING TUITION OBLIGATIONS - These students ARE TO REPORT TO SCHOOL at 11:30 am on the regularly scheduled exam day prepared to take that day's scheduled exams.
